Week Three: "The Antichrist"
Mark 13:14-18

TEACHING NOTES

Matthew 24:15 – *"So when you see the **abomination of desolation spoken of by the prophet Daniel**, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand)..."*

Daniel 9:27 – *And he shall make a strong covenant with many for one week, and for half of the week he shall put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of **abominations shall come one who makes desolate**, until the decreed end is poured out on the desolator.*

Daniel 12:11 – *And from the time that the regular burnt offering is taken away and the **abomination that makes desolate** is set up, there shall be 1,290 days.*

Daniel 11:31 – Forces from him shall appear and profane the temple and fortress, and shall take away the regular burnt offering. And they shall set up the **abomination that makes desolate**.

1 John 2:18 – Children, it is the last hour, and as you have heard that antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have come. Therefore we know that it is the last hour.

1 John 4:2-3 – By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you heard was coming and now is in the world already.

- **Daniel 7:21** – As I looked, this horn made war with the saints and prevailed over them...
- **Daniel 7:25** – He shall...wear out the saints of the Most High...

2. He will rule by _____ if possible and _____ when needed

- **Daniel 7:23-24** – Thus he said: “As for the fourth beast, there shall be a fourth kingdom on earth, which shall be different from all the kingdoms, and it shall devour the whole earth, and trample it down, and break it to pieces. As for the ten horns, out of this kingdom ten kings shall arise, and another shall arise after them; he shall be different from the former ones, and shall put down three kings.”

- **Daniel 7:25** – *He shall...think to change the times and the law...*

4. He will be a _____

- **Daniel 8:23-25** – *And at the latter end of their kingdom, when the transgressors have reached their limit, a king of old face, one who understands riddles, shall arise. His power shall be great – but not by his own power...By his cunning he shall make deceit prosper under his hand...*

5. He will be an absolute _____

- **Daniel 11:36a** – *And the king shall do as he wills...*

6. He will consider himself a _____ and so will the world

- **Daniel 11:36b** – *He shall exalt himself and magnify himself above every god...*

7. He will be the biggest _____ the world has seen

- **Daniel 11:36c** - *...and shall speak astonishing things against the God of gods.*

8. He will have no respect for _____ or _____

- **Daniel 11:37** – *He shall pay no attention to the gods of his fathers, or to the one beloved by women. He shall not pay attention to any other god, for he shall magnify himself above all.*

9. He will worship _____ might

- **Daniel 11:38** – *He shall honor the god of fortresses instead of these. A god whom his fathers did not know he shall honor with gold and silver, with precious stones and costly gifts.*

10. He will claim _____

- **2 Thessalonians 2:3-4** – *Let no one deceive you in any way: For that day will not come unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God.*

11. He will perform _____

- **2 Thessalonians 2:9** – *The coming of the lawless one is by the activity of Satan with all power and false signs and wonders.*

12. He is from the _____

- **Revelation 11:7** – *And when they have finished their testimony, the beast that rises from the bottomless pit will make war on them and conquer them and kill them.*
- **Revelation 12:7-9** – *Now war arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon. And the dragon and his angels fought back, but he was defeated, and there was no longer any place for them in heaven. And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world – he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.*
- **Revelation 13:1** – *And I saw a beast rising out of the sea, with ten horns and seven heads, with ten diadems on its horns and blasphemous names on its heads.*

13. He will be empowered by _____

- **Revelation 13:2** – *And the beast that I saw was like a leopard; its feet were like a bear's and its mouth was like a lion's mouth. And to it the dragon gave his power and his throne and great authority.*

14. He will appear to be _____ and _____

- **Revelation 13:3,12** – *One of its heads seemed to have a mortal wound, but its mortal wound was healed, and the whole earth marveled as they followed the beast...It exercises all authority of the first beast in its presence, and makes the earth and its inhabitants worship the first beast, whose mortal wound was healed.*

15. He will demand _____

- **Revelation 13:4** – *And they worshiped the dragon, for he had given his authority to the beast, and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast, and who can fight against it?"*

16. He will be the epitome of _____ and _____

- **Revelation 13:5-7** – *And the beast was given a mouth uttering haughty and blasphemous words, and it was allowed to exercise authority for forty-two months. It opened its mouth to utter blasphemies against God, blaspheming his name and his dwelling, that is, those who dwell in heaven. Also it was allowed to make war on the saints and to conquer them. And authority was given it over every tribe and people and language and nation.*
