

Read Numbers 13:26-14:9

- 2. Why is it difficult to take a stand against popular opinion? Do you have an example of when you had to stand up for truth when it was not popular?

- 1. Based on these verses and your experience, do you agree or disagree with that statement?
- 2. Do you know of anyone who got off to a great start in life, but in their middle years they lost it? What do you think were the reasons they did not remain consistent and faithful?
- 3. Caleb had to wander in the wilderness for 40 years even though it was the failure of the other spies and the disobedience of the people of Israel that caused the delay of entering the promised land. Do you think you would

have been tempted to give up during those 40 years if you were Caleb? Why or why not? What do you think sustained Caleb during those 40 years of waiting and wandering?
