Job Description

Position Summary:

This part-time position serves the Lead Children's Pastor to ensure that a spirit of excellence is fostered throughout the kids ministries of Eastridge Church. The Nursery and Childcare Director is responsible to build and lead a team to care for babies and toddlers to establish, from the earliest age, a spiritual foundation rooted in Jesus Christ.

Job Type: Part-Time, Non-Exempt, 15 to 20 hours per week

Nursery Director General Responsibilities:

The Nursery and Childcare Director serves to bring a spirit of excellence to the Eastridge staff by (including but not limited to):

- Staffing classrooms
 - Making sure that every service has well-qualified workers (Sat 5:00, Sun 9:00, 11:00, Wed 7:00)
 - Scheduling and communication
 - Appreciating and recognizing the service of our workers through cards, emails, and personal conversations.
- Recruiting
 - Actively recruit volunteers
 - Participate in Kids Ministry planning and execution
 - Following the interview and onboarding process with nursery volunteers
- Training
 - Participate in planning and execution of Team Nights
 - Scheduling and following through on orientation of new volunteers
 - Clearly communicating all expectations (arrive 45 min early, attend team huddles, and be in position 15 minutes before service)
- Equipping

Weekly updates and communicating with the Logistics Administrator managing volunteers, curriculum, and budget.

- Curriculum
 - Sending teachers materials for class at least 3 days before their scheduled service time, and prepping or arranging prep of any necessary materials
- Supplies
 Making sure all supplies are well stocked and organized
- Environments

Weekly updates and communicating with the Operations Administrator managing environments and workflow.

- Ensuring new families are warmly greeted and introduced to nursery procedure
- Making sure the nursery is clean, inviting, and well organized
- Looking for equipment that needs repair or replacing, communicating to facilities team
- Keep an eye out for ways to better our environments
- Implementing policies and procedures
 - Bathroom and diaper changing policy, check in/check out procedures, emergency procedures, etc.

 - Christmas Eve Service
 - Etc.
- Signing and turning in reimbursement forms for childcare workers
- Managing Childcare budget and communicating overages to the Lead Children's Pastor and Logistics Administrator.
